Category Overview

Cutting, cutting, cutting, pasting, cutting, pasting, pasting; for the first time ever, Muse invites you to lose yourself in the tedium of collage making. Find objects, textures and create patterns, arrangements, compositions until you're satisfied (or, knowing you, until the time runs out).

Round 1

Day 1 - Delegates are to explore the campus and photograph scenes, images and objects based on one <u>assigned</u> theme from the following: (1) Junoon, (2) Sunlit, (3) Shadow..

Judging Criteria

• This round will not be scored.

Round 2

Days 2 & 3 - Delegates are tasked with creating original artwork(s), and then using it in an A4-size collage incorporating the images they took from Round 1, and other items and elements as well.

Judging Criteria

- (15) Communication How well does the artwork communicate the chosen theme?
- (15) Composition How coherent and compelling is the artwork as an image?
- (10) Presentation How neat and polished is the finished artwork?
- (10) Innovation How transformative it is of the original photographs, how much has the artist contributed outside of existing references, and to what effect?

(50 marks total)

Rules

- This is an individual category: delegations may register as many people as they like but every participant must work independently
- Theme will be randomly assigned by the category heads on event-day
- Delegates may not alter their theme assignment
- All photography must be done on-campus, on event-day
- All photos must be submitted to category heads by the end of Day 1
- Generative AI is strictly prohibited for image manipulation
- Delegates are allotted 8 hours, and are free to allocate and use their time as they please throughout the scheduled hours for art categories
- Submissions must be an A4 piece including at least one original artwork created by the delegate



STUDY GUIDE

- Images used for the collage or reference material must be the delegates' own; no internet references are allowed.
- All traditional art media are welcome
- All delegates are expected to bring their own materials
- The artworks are to be submitted to the category heads when delegates are not working on it
- Depicting profane/sexual/violent/explicit content will earn offenders a disqualification and/or disciplinary action at the sole discretion of the equity board
